# BELIZE AIRPORTS AUTHORITY (AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT AND PASSENGER SERVICE FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2005,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Belize Airports Authority (Airport Development and Passenger Service Fees) Regulations, 2004, which are hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and replaced by the following: -

Repeal and replacement of Regulation 5.

"5. The classes and categories of persons set out in the Schedule hereto shall be exempt from the payment of airport development fee and passenger service fee levied under Regulations 3 and 4, respectively."

Addition of Schedule.

3. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the addition thereto of the Schedule to these Regulations.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on 7th day of November, 2005.
